Thursday, July 9

Station Sponsors & Cookers

Stations can set up Thursday, July 9th from 4:30-6pm or between 7:30am and 8:30am on Friday. ASC staff will direct you to your course / station. Setup must be complete by 8:30am. You should expect to have approximately 70-80 shooters come through your station. Don't forget the cold drinks (ice can be purchased onsite). Sunscreen and mosquito repellent would be great as well. Make sure we have your name(s) so you can be entered into our drawings.

Friday, July 10

Volunteers

Please plan to arrive between 7:15 - 7:30am. We shouldn't need trappers this year but there will be other things to do. I will send assignments prior. Ear and eye protection is required on the course and available onsite. Make sure you stick around for lunch & volunteer prize drawings.

Check-In, Breakfast & Warm-ups – 7:30am

To help avoid congestion, we are asking that **ONLY TEAM CAPTAINS** check in. Captains will make any changes if necessary, pickup warm. Team entry gifts will be picked up Team Captain. Scorecards will be on your first station. For non-sponsored teams, warm-up tickets can be purchased onsite. Thank you, **Carlos Torres with Royal Oaks** for breakfast!

Safety Meeting - 8:45am

Each shooter must attend the safety meeting. Waivers must be signed prior to shooting and will be located at your first station. Ear and eye protection are required and will be available onsite.

Tournament Kickoff - 9:00am

We are running on 3 courses. Starting course and station assignments will be posted on site as well as printed on the scorecard. Format is 100 targets / no mulligans. **12 & 20 gauge ammo is included and can be picked up onsite.** Tickets will be given to the team captain at check-in.

Lunch, Door Prizes, Gun Drawings, Gun Squares

Lunch will be cooked by **Premier Coil Solutions** and beer by **FET Global Tubing**. Be sure to stick around during lunch. We will be giving away 1 gun per team as well as a few door prizes. Rules

- **Gun actions MUST be kept open and unloaded** except when in the shooting stand.
- **ABSOLUTELY no alcohol allowed before or during the shooting event.** Alcohol will be available during lunch only.
- **Safety glasses and earplugs are required** in all shooting areas and will be available onsite.
- Winners of handguns must be 21 years or older. Out of state winners will pay shipping to the FFL of their choice. Recipients must pass a federal background check (done onsite) to receive firearm; otherwise the award will be forfeited to the USA Chapter of ICoTA. Firearms are nontransferable and forfeited if not claimed within 30 days.
